SCHOOL FEES 2021 – GRADE R & GRADE 1 – GRADE 7

Dear Parents/Guardians

At a meeting held on the 5 November 2020, the proposed budget for 2021 was formally and officially presented by the School Governing Body, and we are delighted that the budget and the school fees for 2021 was unanimously adopted. There will be no increase in the school fees except for Grade R. We, however, appeal to parents to make every effort to pay their fees every month.

The fees structure for 2021 is as follows:

Grade R R8500-00 p.a.	R2000-00 payable on acceptance	R8500-00 less R2000- leaves a balance of R6500-00	R650-00 per month from January to October 2021
New Learners Grade 1 to 7 R7500-00 p.a.	R2000-00 payable on acceptance.	R7500-00 less R2000-00 leaves a balance of R5500-00	R550-00 per month from January to October 2021
Existing Learners R7500-00 p.a.	R2000-00 before 15 December 2020	R7500-00 less R2000-00 leaves a balance of R5500-00	R550-00 per month from January to October 2021
